Off-campus Activity Any activity involving students which at least part of the divity occursoffcampus, incluing field trips, field schools esearch practicum clinical, coop or work experience placements, student exchanges, conferences, seminars,-extracular activities that involve the formal



representation of the College by student representatives as collegiate athletics and off-site discipline based events.

Off-campus ActivityPlan: A document that provides planning and preparation details related to the activity and serves as the official record of an **Off**mpus Activityundertaken by the College.

Responsible AdministratorThe Dean Directoror Manager to whom the Group Leader reports.

Risk: A situation involving exposure to danger, harm, injury or loss.

RiskAssessmentA documentin which the Group Lead(s) and Responsible Administrator assess the overalllevel of Riskin an Off-campus Activity

Risk RegisterA document that identifiesspecificRisks that may arise during an Other may activity and describes detailed mitigation plans to reduce the leves of all Risks associated with the activity.
