A. PURPOSE

B. SCOPE

This policy applies to allembers of the College Community

Limitation of Scope

This policy does not apply to

- x the possession use of Firearms by olice officers, peace officers formployees of armored car services during the course of carrying out their duties on College Campuses and Properties; or
- x the possession or use ofility knives or other tools where used by am Boyee to carry out work assignments or
- x the bearing or wearing of ceremonial weap**dha**t serveor fulfil religious and/or cultural purposesor obligations.



- a. The possession use of Firearms, Explosives or Weapomequined for the purposes of research, teaching and/or learning, including in theatrical productions
- b. There are ther circumstances that the Director, SSRMems reasonable and thatill not cause concern or alartor pose a threat to safety
- Campus Security will contact applicable law enforcement authorities regarding any Weapons found on Campus for which there is no written authorization; any Weapons that are seized will be turned over to police.
- 4. Individuals found with unauthorized Weapons on Campus may be subject to the appropriate disciplinary process as well as criminal prosecution
- 5. Any member of the College Community who observes an individual possessing, transferring, selling or using a Weapon anetasonably believes that the individual has not been specifically authorized to do so by the Collegend/or who perceives the individual to be posing a threat or a potential threat should immediately call 911 and then report to Campus Security.

E. PROCEDURES

- 1. Individual members of the College Community must apply to the Director, SSRM for prior authorization possess, deliver, store or use any Firearms, Explosives or Weapons on College Campuses or Properties.
- 2. Once an exception is authorized to Director, SSRM will notify Campus Security of the nature and duration of the presence and use of, and the agreed secure storage methods for, the Weapon(s).
