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For regular semester length courses:

- where seats are available, students may add courses or changecourses or sections until the end of the first week of classes (Sunday). Students may add courses or changecourses or sections during the secondweek of classes with permission from the instructor, in accordance with departmental guidelines.
- x Students may withdraw from courses until the end of the second

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Unless otherwise instructed, students are expected to attend all classes of courses in which they are enrolled and excessive absence (as defined in an instructor's course outline and departmental policy) may be considered sufficient cause for dismissal from a course, resulting in a grade of W, UN or F as appropriate (see <u>Grading Systems</u> policy). Regular fees will be assessed and payable in accordance with the college fee payment and refund policy.
