1. The student, workplace supervisor, and work-experience faculty member will participate in the evaluation process.

2. The workplace supervisor will evaluate the student's work, attendance, and attitude.

3. The work-experience faculty member will make at least one site visit and do an evaluation during the work experience.

4. A minimum of 180 hours of field experience and satisfactory work production must be met to receive a Mastery grade.
